



Township of Lakewood Recreation Program Parents & Participants Responsibilities

Arrival: Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the program. Doors open at 8:45am. Attendance is taken from 8:45am - 9:00am. You must walk your child to their counselor and sign them in. Camp starts July 1st and ends on August 9th. No camp July 4th. Breakfast served 8:45am – 9:30am.

Dismissal: Dismissal begins at 2:30pm. All children must be off premises by 3:00pm. Please be prompt. You must pick your child up from their counselor and sign them out at their designated dismissal area. No walkers: Campers will not be released from camp to walk home alone. A parent/guardian or authorized person 18 years or older must pick up the camper from camp.

Late Arrivals: You must walk your child to the site director and sign in.

Early Dismissals: You must meet your child with their counselor and sign out. Those children being picked up prior to 2:30pm will need to sign out.

Trips & Special Activities: Activity calendars will be on hand at the park site and included with your welcoming packet. Written permission is required to participate on any special event. Return permission slip forms on the first day of camp.

Attire: Children need to dress appropriately for the day's weather and activity. Sneakers are a must for safety. Shoes with wheels, open toe-shoes and flip flops are not acceptable footwear and cannot be worn to camp. Socks are necessary for any activity that requires the removal of your own shoes. **Recreation Tee Shirts are required on all participants attending a trip.** Children without the appropriate shirts will not be permitted on any trips. The only shirts permitted are the tee shirts given out by the Township Staff on the first day of camp.

Medication: Township Staff is not permitted to administer medications of any kind.

Accessories: Please be aware of your responsibility when wearing or bringing any accessory to a Township program. Be sure your child does not bring valuable personal items. **The Township of Lakewood does not accept responsibility for broken, lost, or stolen personal property.**

Summer Camp Objective: The safety and enjoyment of all participants, staff, and property is of the utmost importance to the Township of Lakewood. Anyone who presents himself/herself as a conflict of that interest will be held accountable by the Township of Lakewood.

Code of Conduct: All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will bring respect to themselves, their families, and the Township of Lakewood.

Accountable Conduct: Anything that is or resembles a weapon (of any kind) should not be brought to Summer Camp. Any person who deliberately causes or assists with the theft or destruction of private or program property will be suspended from the program. Physical confrontations, foul language, provoking remarks, instigating attitudes, or improper gestures will not be tolerated. There is no smoking on public property.

The Township of Lakewood reserves the right to suspend or expel, any participant deemed necessary for the safety of the program and its participants.
