sewer line improvement project to start soon

New Jersey American Water is partnering with Lakewood Township to install 4,200 feet of 18-inch sewer main along Oak Street, Clyde Avenue, Argyle Avenue and Broadway Avenue in Lakewood Township.

As our neighbor and a valued customer, we wanted to provide you with information on this project and address questions you may have. The \$2.3 million project represents a critical investment for the company in support of our commitment to provide customers with high-quality, reliable wastewater service. The project will be completed by a qualified contractor, Bil-Jim Construction Company. To minimize impact to customers, the project will be completed in two phases:

Phase 1: The replacement and installation of approximately 1,100 feet of 18-inch sewer main on Oak Street between Cypress Avenue and the Oak Street Public School entrance. Construction should start on/or about July 7, 2014, and should be completed within 5-6 weeks. Please become familiar with the detour signs as the construction takes place in this area. Final paving for this project should be completed by the end of 2014 or spring 2015.

Phase 2: This phase of the project will start immediately after Phase One is complete. This will consist of installing approximately 3,100 feet of 18-inch sewer pipe on Clyde, Argyle and Broadway Avenues. These roadways are undeveloped and the local residents should not expect any traffic impacts from this construction. Please keep in mind that equipment and material may be transported to this area during construction and caution should be used at all times.

Frequently Asked Questions

When will construction start/end?

New Jersey American Water's contractor will begin the pipeline installation in July. Weather permitted, all new pipe should be installed by year's end. Final paving and restoration work will take place in the spring of 2015.

What will the works hours be?

Work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday. Weekend work could take place if needed to maintain project schedule.

Why install new pipe? Increasing the size of the sewer main along these streets will help support current customers as well as anticipated growth in the community.

Will my water/sewer service be disrupted? We do not anticipate any disruptions to your water or sewer service as a result of this project. There may be cases where there is a brief interruption of service when some service lines from the homes are interconnected with the new sewer main. In these events, impacts should be minimal.

Will there be noise? Our contractor will be taking measures to minimize noise levels related to the installation of the new pipe; however, there will be some unavoidable noise associated with this project, so we do apologize in advance for any inconvenience that this may cause.

Will access to the area be impacted?

During the course of construction, road detours will be required. We will provide 24 hours notice to those impacted, so that you can find alternate parking locations (cars parked in the construction zones may be towed by the Township). Trash services will continue throughout the duration of the project. Please place your trash cans at the curbside as usual on trash day, and our contractor will arrange to have the cans emptied at a safe location and returned to your curbside. Mail will continue to be delivered during the project.

Will you maintain the work site?

The project site will be maintained daily and cleaned each night before contractors have completed work.
