AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKEWOOD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING SUPPLEMENTING AND CHAPTER ENTITLED 11 "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKEWOOD, **SPECIFICALLY SECTION 2-76 (FEES** FOR MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES AND COPIES OF PUBLIC DOCUMENTS).

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lakewood, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter II entitled "Administration" of the revised general ordinances of the Township of Lakewood, specifically Section 2-76.1 entitled "Fees for Miscellaneous Services" be and hereby is amended and supplemented as follows:

2-76.1. Fees for Miscellaneous Services.

- d. Certified copies of birth, marriage, fetal death, death, domestic partnership or civil union records, ten (\$10.00) dollars each.
- e. <u>Certified copy of death certificate, twenty (\$20.00) dollars for</u> the first copy, two (\$2.00) dollars for each additional copy.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance not directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
