## **PUBLIC COMMENT**

**Comments from the public will be heard for a limit of one (1) hour. Each speaker will have four (4) minutes and shall be limited to one time at the podium.**

Mayor Coles opened the meeting to the public.

Shlomi Klein, 189 Chateau Drive, expressed dissatisfaction with a new shopping center built near his home without sidewalks. Mr. Klein objected to the management of the property particularly because it was without sidewalks. Mr. Klein objected to Council Members having any involvement with the project. Mayor Coles discussed sidewalks and the Council's dedication to ensuring residents safety.

Moishe Zienes, 412 Elmhurst Blvd, spoke on behalf of the crossing guards and reminded persons to clear their car windows when driving to ensure they have visibility when driving on Township roads. Mr. Zienes also noted that persons on bicycles should have a helmet and need to follow the flow of traffic for their safety and the safety of others.

Lisa Tarzia, 826 Spar Drive, Forked River, commented that the remains of deceased chickens are allegedly being removed by U-hauls. Ms. Tarzia expressed concern of how sanitary that may be for the rental company.

Silvia Hagenfeld, 1503 Berkowitz Ave. objected to animal cruelty. Ms. Hagenfeld indicated she has a sign objecting to the slaughter of chickens within the Township. Ms. Hagenfeld objected to the process to kill the chickens. Ms. Hagenfeld requested the process be stopped.

John Bell, 69 Whitaker Drive, Toms River, objected to the current Kaparot tradition and requested that coins be used rather than live animals.

Betty Valentine, 305 Ocean Ave, Lakewood, indicated that a trailer has been sitting next to her and being used a place of worship for the last three years without a certificate of occupancy. Ms. Valentine stated the property owner has now gotten a certificate of occupancy. However, Ms. Valentine objected that the property owners still do not have plans on building a permanent structure in the near future. Mayor Coles asked for Ms. Valentine to leave her information so the issue may be reviewed.

Susan Kearney, 1311 Arthur Street, Toms River, questioned the trailer of chickens and why the participants were not charged with animal cruelty. Mayor Coles asked for Ms. Kearney to leave her information with the Clerk.

Ronnie Daldos, 5 Claridge Drive, Elmville, invited Mayor Coles attend the Kaparot tradition in Lakewood next year.

Seeing no one wishing to speak, Mayor Coles closed the meeting to the public.
