We are in receipt of the revised grading plan dated March 24, 2017, last revised June 23, 2017, prepared by your office for the above-referenced project regarding alternative grading. While not shown on the grading plan it was discussed and agreed that landscaping along the curb line of the proposed area of the office building will be provided. As previously noted this office has a concern that once the grade difference and existing trees are removed that people utilizing the gravel parking area may cut through the proposed office building's site, especially after events. Currently the parking lot of the Blue Claws Stadium is contained via the entrances as well as natural barriers around the perimeter. Should people cut through the office's property, this office recommends that the burden of installing additional landscaping, fencing or barriers or other means to prevent such shall be the sole responsibility of the owner of Lot 2.03 Block 961 and that the Township of Lakewood, the Lakewood Industrial Commission and the Blue Claws shall not be required to contribute or install any such barrier to deter said action. Providing the applicant agrees with the recommendations contained herein our office takes no exception to the grading revisions and the grading modifications are accepted as submitted.

### **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT**

\* WHEREAS the governing body of Township of Lakewood entered into an agreement with the County of Ocean on May 3, 2017 for some type of road maintenance, road overlay, hauling of sweepings and repair of the Local Governmental Unit Roads; and

WHEREAS the said governing body of the Township of Lakewood has now requested that they be permitted to increase the amount of the contract.

WITNESSETH that the said parties in consideration of the premises and agreements hereafter contained, do hereby mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The Agreement between County of Ocean and the **Township of Lakewood** dated May 3, 2017 is hereby amended as follows:
- 2. The governing body of the **Township of Lakewood** shall pay to the County Treasurer the additional sum of \$ 350,000. For anticipated expenditures.

### RESOLUTION 170701

Resolution of the Lakewood Industrial Commission authorizing appropriation of funding for the repaving of industrial park roadways under Ocean County's "Schedule C" and reimbursement to the Township of Lakewood for their contractual participation in this repaving program.

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:55B-1 et seq., established and described the purposes of an industrial commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lakewood Industrial Commission by virtue of N.J.S.A. 40:55-B-1 et seq., is statutorily charged with, among other duties, promoting the economic well-being, industrial and economic development of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that a number of Lakewood industrial park roadways are in need of repair; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Ocean had entered into an Agreement with Lakewood Township on May 3, 2017 to perform road maintenance, road overlay, hauling of sweepings and repair of the Local Governmental Unit Roads and has agreed to extend their program under "Schedule C" to Lakewood to include certain industrial park roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of the Lakewood Industrial Commission are supportive of the program for repair and repaving of aged industrial park roadways to provide safe travel to and from Lakewood industrial park businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated cost of the repaving of designated areas of (1) Swarthmore Avenue, (2) Bennett Boulevard, (3) Towbin Avenue, and (4) Oberlin Avenue is \$350,000.00 if performed under "Schedule C"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lakewood Industrial Commission has adequate funds available to reimburse the Township of Lakewood for their financial outlay in this repair program.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Lakewood Industrial Commission shall support the repaving program for Lakewood industrial park roadways and shall provide funding in the amount of \$350,000.00 to the Township of Lakewood in their extension of their current contract with the County of Ocean under Schedule C.

#### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that

- The Executive Director be and is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents to facilitate performance in this program
- Payment will be provided to the Township of Lakewood upon demand in the conclusion of this program.
- An authenticated copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Mayor, Township Committee, the Chief Financial Officer and Township Manager.
