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### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

### 22 Lakewood Airport:

- Airport T-Hangar construction is coming along awaiting delivery of the materials
- Taxi lanes have been paved (and overflow parking). Comments from airport users. Not paved is the final connectors to the new taxiways.
- Runway-end 6 (RWE6) land acquisition
  - Negotiations with Lakewood Township have concluded to remove obstructions from the RWE6 area which ended up with the Township's acquisition of acreage from Church & Dwight. This acquisition will permit relocation of an existing fence which currently creates an obstruction to the runway. Additional runway length can be recaptured once this fence is relocated away from the runway end.
    - Question regarding requirement to have a fence around a detention basin.
      - Not required we have a fence around the airport. Part of the overall fencing system.
      - We will continue to permit Church and Dwight access to perform required tests.
  - o FAA & NJDOT will now be contacted for authorization to recapture additional runway landing area (a few hundred feet).
- CAFRA regulations apply to a good portion of Lakewood development including Lakewood Airport. The taxiway and runway were once connected by pavement. Federal regulations had changed and Lakewood was required to build a new taxiway. Procedurally, a request for CAFRA assessment and review was made. CAFRA took no action for about a year. Construction proceeded as planned. CAFRA came back to Lakewood a year+ and requested their fees for the Permit. Objection was filed. Negotiations took place. Result being-Lakewood put together an agreement for a 5-year plan of development at Lakewood Airport and this will be presented to CAFRA who will act on the entire plan for airport activities/improvements (instead of a permit per each component). CAFRA will get their requested fee. This expense would be funded in part by the FAA & NJDOT with a 5% match from Lakewood Township.

### Request for a grant of Utility Easement –

- New office building under construction is requesting acreage to be dedicated to install sewer laterals across lands owned by the Industrial Commission.
  - o Requesting that the LIC provide an easement across lands along the perimeter of the Stadium property to be dedicated for utility easement.
- Question regarding this new construction in this Redevelopment area, is Lakewood Township receiving taxes from these projects?
  - Yes, we do get tax revenue from them but not in the 'normal' calculation of taxes and application of Project Tax Abatement (if warranted). Some of these new buildings have entered into PILOT agreements with Lakewood Township where the taxation formula is more complex.
