Lakewood Airport will host the first public information meeting on Thursday, January 15, 2026, from 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM, at the Lakewood Airport Administrative (FBO) Building as part of the Airport's Master Planning Process.

Lakewood Airport is in the process of developing an updated Airport Master Plan and Airport Layout Plan (ALP), which will help develop a vision for the future of the airport. The Airport Master Plan is being prepared in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) guidance and is principally funded by New Jersey State DOT grants. This public meeting will serve as an opportunity for the community to learn about the Airport Master Plan process and provide input on the project's progress.

The Airport's last Master Plan and ALP study was completed in 2006. In the intervening 20 years, there have been many changes to the Airport and the aviation industry. This has motivated the Airport to pursue this master planning effort to ensure that it is prepared to accommodate future demand, while optimizing the use of its resources, continuing to provide for the aviation community, and being a community asset to the Lakewood Township and surrounding communities.

Your participation will provide a valuable contribution to the preparation of the Airport Master Plan. We encourage you to join us, and we welcome your continued participation in the master planning process.

Please note that admission will begin at 6:00 pm. Online survey and comment forms will be available. Seating will be limited. Information stations will be set up for the public to go from station to station to learn about the current progress and provide feedback.
